

# Urgent Care **Clinic**

**The Latrobe Urgent Care Clinic (UCC) in Moe provides GP-led care for non-life-threatening conditions, without the need for you to visit an emergency department.**

**If you are experiencing any of the following illnesses or injuries, visit the Latrobe UCC instead of emergency:**

- mild to moderate infections
- fever
- pain when urinating
- suspected minor fractures and sprains
- back and muscle pain
- minor cuts, burns, and insect or animal bites
- heartburn, vomiting, nausea
- headaches, migraines and brief fainting
- constipation, diarrhoea, abdominal pain
- allergies and rashes
- light bleeding in the first trimester of pregnancy
- mild to moderate asthma attacks, coughs and other respiratory symptoms.

The Latrobe UCC accepts walk-ups, referrals and pre-booked appointments, ensuring vital emergency department resources are freed up for patients with more critical needs.

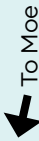
# Urgent Care Clinic

## How to get there

Latrobe Urgent Care Clinic (Moe)

Latrobe Regional Hospital (Traralgon)

Princes Highway



To Moe



By car

- Exit LRH and turn right at the traffic lights.
- Veer left onto the M1 towards Morwell.
- Follow the M1 and exit towards Moe /Newborough.
- Follow the exit and veer left before the traffic lights onto Narracan Drive.
- Continue to the roundabout and take the second exit onto Lloyd Street.
- Turn left onto Fowler Street.
- The Latrobe UCC is 350m on the right.



By bus

- Take bus (route 1) to Moe.
- Get off at Moe railway station.
- From here you can walk 350m up Fowler Street until you reach the Latrobe UCC.
- If you are unable to walk, take bus (route 11) to Moe West.
- Get off at Burrage / Fowler Street stop.
- The Latrobe UCC is across the road.
